

**Degree Roadmap for students who completed the
Transfer AA -T degree in Global Studies or AA-T Social Justice Studies
Catalog Year 2018-19**

SJSU Degree: BA in Behavioral Science

The AA-T in Global Studies or AA-T in Social Justice Studies guarantees the student will transfer with the completion of 60 transferable semester units. Students who earn either of these transfer degrees will meet the 39 units of lower division GE and 21 units of elective credit at SJSU. Below is the path to the BA Behavioral Science degree in 60 semester units for students who earns either the AA-T in Global Studies or AA-T in Social Justice Studies:

Check with a major advisor regarding the most appropriate course sequence for you. 60 units minimum will be transferred with this degree, however up to 70 transfer units can be applied to the lower division and lower division electives if articulated.

** Students must complete at least one of the following courses: ANTH 149, ANTH 165, PSYC 018, PSYC 120, or SOCI 104. A 3-unit maximum of individual studies may be used to meet the degree requirements.
