

**Degree Roadmap for students who completed the
Transfer AS-T degree in Business
Catalog Year 2017-18**

SJSU Degree: BS in Business Administration, Concentration in Management

The AS-T in Business guarantees completion of 60 transferable units and all lower division core GE satisfied. This transfer degree will meet the BUS1 20, 21, BUS3 80 and ECON 1A, 1B requirements at SJSU. Transfers will also take 3 of the following courses: Finite Math, Business Calculus, Statistics, computer skills/Bus info systems, or Intro to Business/Business Comm. We encourage students to complete **BUS2 90, MATH 71, BUS4 91L and ENGL 2 or 1B prior to transfer as part of their associate degree. Below is the path to the BS Business Admin (Management) degree in 60 semester units with the transfer AS-T Business degree: **This major requires grade minimums, please consult with a major advisor.**

Check with a major advisor regarding the most appropriate course sequence for you. 60 units minimum will be transferred with this degree, however up to 70 transfer units can be applied to the lower division and lower division free electives if articulated.

** Transfers are strongly advised to complete MATH 71 prior to transfer in order to be successful in BUS2 190. If BUS2 190 is not passed, students will be required to take MATH 71 before they re-enroll in BUS2 190. Transfers are advised to complete ENGL 2 or 1B prior to transfer for the WST. Transfers are advised to take BUS4 91L prior to transfer. If not taken prior to transfer and do not fit in the roadmap above the student will need to request to have this course waived.
