SJSU Degree: BS in Justice Studies, Concentration in Criminology

The AS-T in Administration of Justice guarantees completion of 60 transferable units and all lower division core GE satisfied. This transfer degree will meet the JS 10 major requirement at SJSU. Below is the path to the BS Justice Studies (Criminology) degree in 60 semester units with the transfer AS-T AJ degree. **Note: A grade of "C" or better is required for courses being used to meet any requirement in this major, including courses in preparation for the major:**
